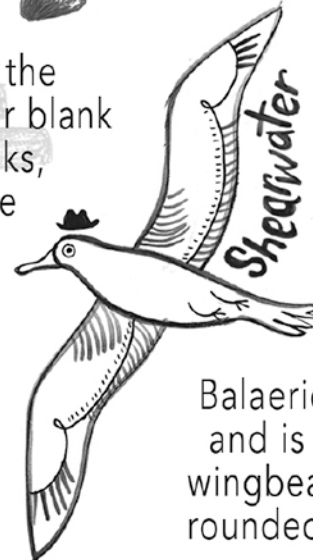
Common TERN



Severn Beach is a paradise for many seabirds. Can you see any of these?

Peregrine falcon: this bird of prey has a huge wingspan, bluey-grey feathers, yellow feet and can fly up to speeds of 200 mph!

Tern: this bird has a long tail, giving it the nickname, 'sea swallow'. They have bright orange beaks and feet and aren't afraid to make a lot of noise!



Sooty and baleric shearwaters: the sooty shearwater is a very dark brown and the Balaeric shearwater is light brown, slightly smaller and is critically endangered. Both fly with rapid wingbeats and have a unique beak shape that's rounded at the end.
