- something in the playpark

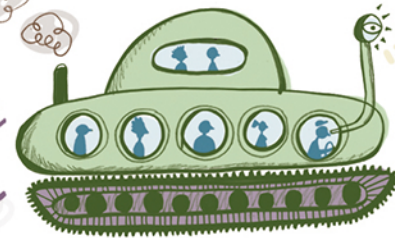


Make BARK ART

... Church Road has existed since the Roman times and used to be known as the 'Old London Way'. In Victorian times it was busy with trams and was known as 'the golden mile' of shops. Can you draw what kind of vehicles you imagine will be here in the future?

At Gaunt's Ham park collect two long, thin sticks to make a giant bubble wand.



Then tie string around both stick ends to make a big loop of string - the size of the loop will change the size of the bubbles you can make. Dip the string loop in a tub of bubble mix and make the biggest bubbles you can!

To make a bubble mix: dissolve two teaspoons of white sugar in two cups of water and add half a cup of dishsoap. Put it in a wide container to make the biggest bubbles!
